1st edition of Singapore Chinese Music Competition 2020 celebrates achievements of outstanding young musicians

- Attracted a total of 335 Chinese and non-Chinese participants
- o 24 years old Deborah Siok emerge as Grand category Champion
- Notable mention: 3 pairs of siblings clinch tops in respective categories

Singapore, 12 December 2020 (Saturday) – After 15 days of intense competition, the Singapore Chinese Music Competition (SCMC) 2020 officially concluded tonight. Organised by the Singapore Chinese Orchestra, the competition received overwhelming responses, attracted 335 Chinese and non-Chinese participants from all walks of life, aged between 7 to 34 years old. Doctor, Engineers, Executives, Teachers and students, to name a few, took part in the Solo (Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Grand) and Ensemble categories.

For the newly added Solo Grand category, 24-year-old Deborah Siok Li Chin (erhu) emerged as the Champion. She is also a member of the Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra since 2016. In tonight's finals, Deborah Siok performed *Amannisha* 《阿曼尼莎》 and impressed audience members with her performance. 19-year-old Li Siyu (erhu) performed *Ode of King of Western Chu*《楚颂》 and won the hearts of the audience, as she was awarded the "Audience Choice Award"; she garnered the most votes on the online voting platform. The other finalist is 20-year-old Fu Zifei (guzheng) who performed *As Thus* 《如 是》. Earlier on, 16 participants made it through the preliminary and semi-finals and the 3 finalists competed for the title.

Selected finalists and the Grand category Champion performed alongside Singapore Chinese Orchestra at the SCO Concert Hall (Singapore Conference Hall) led by SCO Resident Conductor Mr Quek Ling Kiong and SCO Associate Conductor Mr Moses Gay on 11 and 12 December 2020 respectively. Other notable mentions include: 3 pairs of siblings clinch top places in respective solo categories this year and our non-Chinese participants achieved excellent results. For the ensemble category, second-time participant Reverberance clinched champion, and first-

time participants – Xin Sizhu Ensemble and The Purple Symphony won the second and third place respectively. This signals promising and sustained interest for the traditional Chinese music scene ahead.

Celebrating excellence in traditional Chinese music, the competition identifies upcoming talents. SCO Executive Director Terence Ho said: "I was moved, having sat through the entire duration of the competition. I witnessed the rapid development of the Chinese music education in Singapore. Many of our Senior and Open Category repertoires performed back then can now be performed pretty well by the Junior Category participants. And of course, many parents and teachers play an important role in cultivating interests of the younger generation."

President of Singapore Chinese Music Federation Dr Tay Teow Kiat is also one of this year's adjudicator. He said: "Although the Singapore Chinese Orchestra administrative team faced many challenges and restrictions organising the competition amid this COVID-19 period, the team has successfully completed this difficult task well. Not only was there an increase in the number of participants this time round, the overall performance standard has also improved significantly."

Adjudicators also shared their thoughts on the entire competition on 10 December 2020 (Thursday). This online video featured local and overseas adjudicators who shared positive sentiments about the high level of performance standard this SCMC 2020 and they celebrated outstanding achievements of the participants. <u>Click here</u> for the video.

In addition, this was also the first time whereby the competition had local adjudicators present on site and overseas adjudicators tuning in via livestream. There were a total of 27 adjudicators, comprising of 18 local and 9 overseas adjudicators, judging for different categories and sections. The 1st edition of Singapore Chinese Music Competition 2020 was held from 23 November to 12 December 2020. The Singapore Chinese Music Competition 2020, previously known as National Chinese Music Competition, seeks to provide an excellent platform to develop the performing skills of young musicians, raise musical standards, discover new talents, and to connect our people by supporting their lifelong interest in pursuit of Chinese music in Singapore. There is a total of S\$147,700 worth of prizes. (Refer to Annex C for the Prize categories)

Annex D: Write up of Grand category Champion Deborah Siok



Deborah Siok started learning the erhu at 9 under the tutelage of erhu master Zhang Yu Ming and furthered her studies in music performance at NAFA in 2015, graduating with a Bachelor of Music with First Class Honours in 2019. In 2018, she performed Wang I-Yu's erhu concerto "The Blue Planet-Earth" with the Singapore Chinese Orchestra and later that year clinched the First Prize in the Erhu Open category in the NCMC. In 2019 she performed Wang Danhong's erhu concerto "Amannisha" with the Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra both in Singapore as well as in Suzhou, China. She is currently under the tutelage of SCO concertmaster, Li Baoshun.

Deborah is a member of the Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra since 2016.
